Center for Gifted Young Musicians at Temple Music Prep - Audition Criteria

All students should make a video recording of themselves performing one (Baroque Players) or two (Chamber Players or Youth Chamber) contrasting pieces and noted scales. Students who are accepted will be required to participate in a placement/seating audition in the fall which will include sight reading.

The following are minimum repertoire (or <u>equivalent pieces</u>) which demonstrate the basic level required to audition for each of these groups. **Bassists** will please perform repertoire as directed by their teachers. It is critically important that **pianists** have experience sight-reading.

Baroque Players Orchestra

- Ability to play in keys from three sharps to two flats
- Violin
 - Vivaldi: Concerto in a minor, Op. 3, No. 6, First or Third movement or equivalent piece demonstrating shifting and ability to play in Third Position
 - Three octave G-Major scale
- Viola
 - o J.S. Bach: Bourrée or Gavotte from Suzuki Book Three, Seitz: Concerto No. 2 (Mvt. 3) or Concerto No. 5 (Mvt. 1)
 - Two octave C-Major scale
- Cello
 - Vivaldi: Concerto in e minor
 - Two octave C-Major scale

Chamber Players Orchestra

- Violin
 - J.S. Bach: Concerti, Accolay: Concerto in a minor, Mozart: G Major Concerto, Haydn: Concerti
 - Two 3-octave scales: one major and one minor
- Viola
 - o Telemann: Concerto
 - Two 3-octave scales: one major and one minor
- Cello
 - o Saint-Saens: Allegro Appassionato, Golterman: Concerto in G, or equivalent pieces
 - Two 3-octave scales: one major and one minor
- Piano
 - Bach: Inventions, Chopin Impromptus

Youth Chamber Orchestra

Professional repertoire at least at the level of the works listed below

- Violin
 - o Bach solo sonatas/partitias, Mozart D Major or A Major concerti, Bruch g minor concerto
 - Two 3-octave scales: one major and one minor
- Viola
 - A movement from the Bach Cello Suites, plus the first movement of concertos by either Handel, Stamitz, or J.C.
 Bach/H. Casadesus
 - o Two 3-octave scales: one major and one minor
- Cello
 - A movement from the Bach Suites plus a movement from at least the Boccherini Concerto in Bb Major, Haydn C
 Major, or the Saint Saens Concerto No. 1 in a minor.
 - o Two 3-octave scales: one major and one minor
- Piano
 - Chopin Etudes, Debussy Preludes, First or Last Movement of a Beethoven, Mozart, Haydn Sonata
