About the Artist

Paolo Taballione was born in Rome in 1981. After graduating from the Santa Cecilia Conservatory in Rome with highest honors in the class of Gaetano Schiavone in 2001, he studied in Switzerland at the Conservatoire Supérieur de Musique de Genève in the class of Jacques Zoon, where he earned the Diplôme de Soliste with unanimous approval in 2007. In addition to intensive flute, in 1998 he began studying piano and composition, a discipline in which he graduated with honors in the class of Francesco Carotenuto at the Santa Cecilia Conservatory in 2008.

His repertoire, ranging from baroque to contemporary music, led him to be a very young winner of numerous national and international solo competitions, including first prize at the Valentino Bucchi International Competition for Music of the XX and XXI Century (given by ISCM) for flute and piccolo in 2004 and first prize by unanimous vote at the D. Cimarosa International Flute Competition in 2005.

He went on to perform as a soloist, chamber musician, and orchestral player in the most important concert halls in Europe, including the Musikverein in Vienna, Gasteig in Munich, the Festspielhaus in Salzburg, the Berlin Philharmonie, the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam, Auditorium Parco della musica in Rome, Beethovensaal in Stuttgart, Konzertsaal del KKL in Lucerne, Teatro San Carlo in Naples. He has also played as a soloist with such orchestras as the Bavarian State Orchestra, Bach Collegium München, Orchestra Reino de Aragón, I Cameristi di Santa Cecilia, and Georgian Sinfonietta.

Paolo Taballione is currently solo flutist of the Bavarian State Opera in Munich, Germany and a flute professor at the Mozarteum University in Salzburg, Austria. He plays of a 19,5K Rose Gold Custom Powell Flute.
